Do you face these problems at your facility?

- a** Old, outdated equipment in your buildings.
- a** Recurring equipment problems that take up valuable staff time.
- a** Too many demands on your time and budget.

If so, here's the good news . . .

You can make the energy upgrades you need now and pay for them through the energy savings that result. Best of all, those savings can be guaranteed. How? Through energy performance contracting and assistance provided by the Kentucky Division of Energy in cooperation with the Energy Services Coalition (ESC).

Here's how it works:

Kentucky statutes KRS 45A.343 through KRS 45A.460 govern performance contracting in K-12 schools.

Once an energy services provider is selected, energy-related savings opportunities will be identified and evaluated. Together, the customer and the provider develop a package of facility improvements that maximizes building efficiency. These upgrades may fund themselves by reducing operational costs and reallocating the savings to pay for the improvements.

The energy services provider guarantees that projected savings meet or exceed annual payments to cover all project costs over the contract term. If savings don't materialize, the provider pays the difference. To help ensure savings, the energy services provider offers staff training and long-term maintenance services.

Many types of building improvements, including new lighting technologies, more efficient HVAC and energy management controls can be funded through existing budgets.
