Project Scope



- HVAC Improvements-includes:
 - New Full Condensing Boiler,
 - Dedicated Heat Recovery Chiller to run from heat generated by TV equipment,
 - New Hot Water Coil and New Second Floor HVAC equipment,
 - Re-bid Natural Gas Contract (saved \$21K per year)
 - Replaced individual space heaters with foot warmers 1500 watts vs. 80 watts
- Building envelope upgrades (window film and sealing)
- Digital control upgrades that can be networked to the KET's IT infrastructure
- Lighting upgrade, controls and occupancy sensors
- Vending machine occupancy controls
- Domestic water improvements to save water and waste water costs
